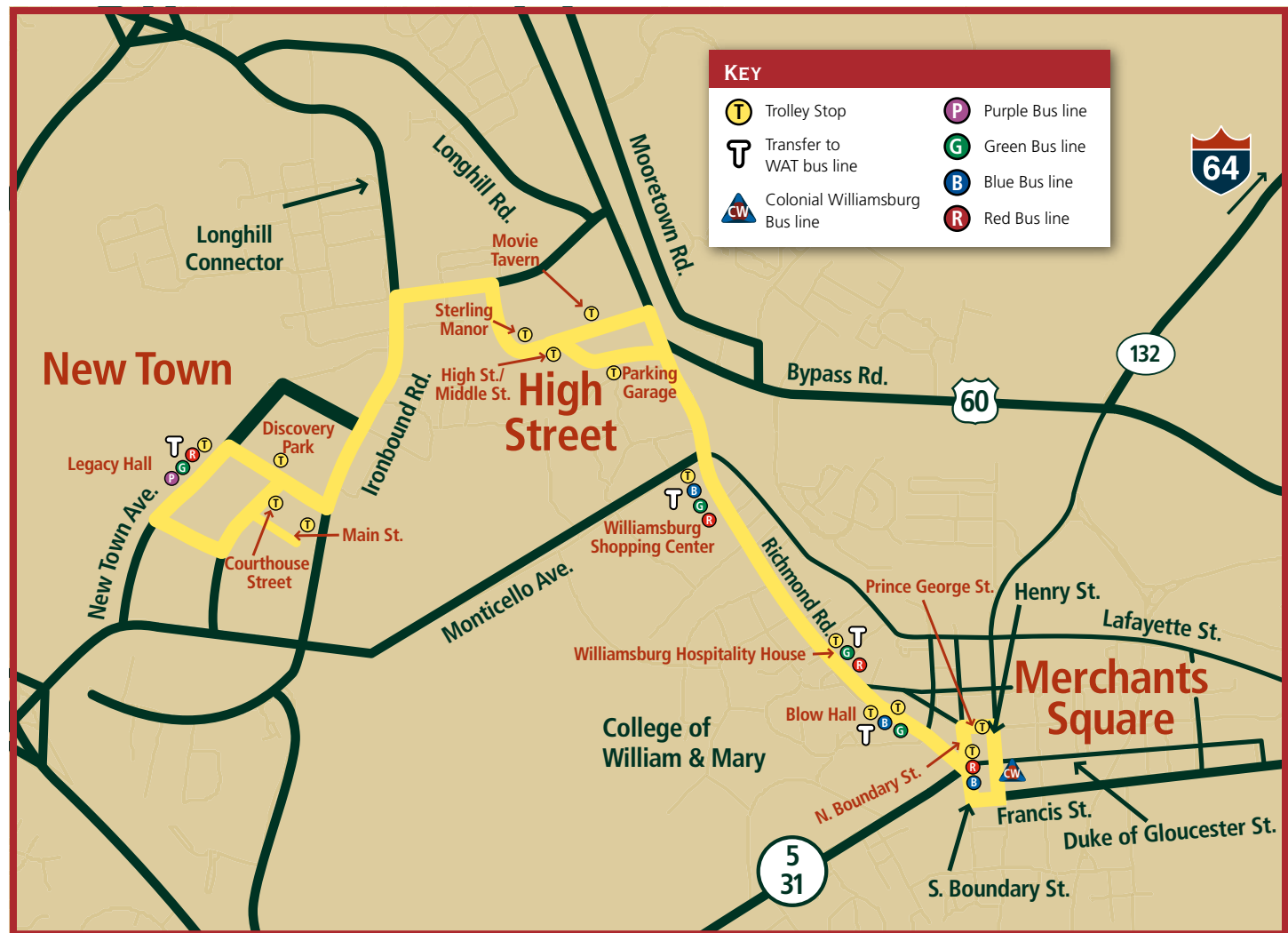

The Williamsburg Area Transit Authority proudly introduces the colorful red and green *Williamsburg Trolley*. For visitors, area residents and students, the Trolley is a new, inexpensive and fun way to travel to our area's favorite destinations.

Ride with us and *travel in style*. Each of our three trolley cars features ornamental wooden seating, a cheerful, two-tone red and green exterior and bicycle racks. On warm days, the trolley has an open-air atmosphere. During your trip, the driver will point out historic sites, restaurants and must-visit attractions.

The trolley operates a continuous loop daily to *Williamsburg's favorite communities of Merchants Square, the Williamsburg Shopping Center, High Street and New Town*, including stops near the College of William & Mary. Convenient connection points along the route make it easy to transfer to Williamsburg Area Transport or Colonial Williamsburg buses.

For only 50¢ a ride, the Trolley is your economical transportation alternative. So, sit back and relax – you can forget about traffic and parking hassles when you take a trip on the *Williamsburg Trolley*.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FARES

- \$.50 cents all-day fare. **Exact fare only**, operators do not carry change or currency.
- Seniors (60 and over) and/or disabled with a Medicare card can ride for \$.25 cents.
- Children under six who do not occupy a seat and are accompanied by an adult ride at no charge.
- The College of William & Mary students with a school ID ride at no charge.
- Middle and high school students with a school student's ID who reside in James City County, the City of Williamsburg and York County ride at no charge.

OPERATION OF SERVICES

- Our Trolley service operates seven days a week:
Monday - Thursday 3:00pm - 10:00pm
Friday & Saturday 3:00pm - 11:00pm
Sunday 12:00pm - 8:00pm

HOLIDAY CLOSURES

- New Year's Day (January 1)
- Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November)
- Christmas Day (December 25)

REGULATIONS

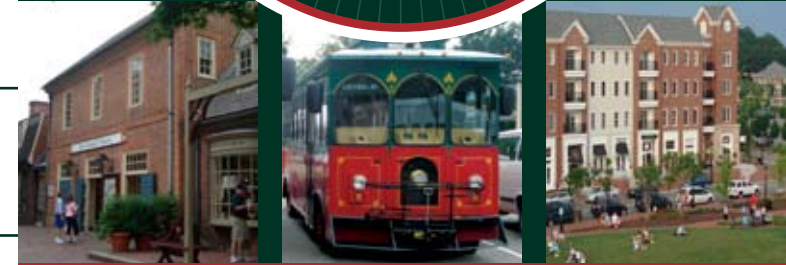
- Please remain seated until the Trolley stops.
- Notify the driver in advance by pulling the overhead cord when you want to depart the Trolley.
- When you depart, please do not walk in front of the Trolley. Wait until the Trolley leaves so you can look both ways and safely cross the street.
- No radios except with earphones.
- No food or drink in open containers is allowed.
- No littering or smoking is allowed.

PASSENGER SAFETY TIPS

- Plan your trip; call WATA at 757-220-5493 if you need assistance.
- Advise a family member, friend or co-worker of your travel route and time.
- Find a seat on the aisle if possible.
- Don't doze off or become too focused on any one thing that you are not aware of surroundings and behavior around you.
- Keep your purse, shopping bag or other valuables in your lap, on your arm or between your feet.
- Alert driver immediately concerning any unsafe conditions aboard the Trolley or at any Trolley stop.
- Report your concerns directly by calling Williamsburg Area Transit Authority at 757-220-5493.
